



Judging Criteria: 2021 Leadership in Advancing the Patient Voice Award

1. Impact

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Contributions by patients, caregivers and family members to improve care take many forms. Scoring in this category will consider how the nominee supported collaborative efforts and advanced the patient voice to address challenges in the health care system.

2. Leadership

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This category considers how the nominee motivated and supported others to work together in pursuit of a common goal. Examples include supporting others to participate in improvement activities, eliminating power imbalances, demonstrating characteristics such as honesty and integrity, creating connections, and fostering an environment that encourages everyone to contribute.

3. Inspiration

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The nominee inspired patients, caregivers or family members to engage in efforts to improve quality of care; inspired health care organizations to seek opportunities to engage patients, caregivers or family members; and/or inspired both of these groups to work together in collective action. The nominee's volunteerism demonstrated a commitment to and passion for improving health care for members of their community.
